

## Nancy's Notes for Captains

1. Remind your new members to join the hole in one fund.
2. The easy website address is: <http://coachellis.com> and click on Sun Valley 9 in the upper right hand corner or click here for the actual address: <http://general.fastq.com/~nlellis/sunvalley9/schedule.htm>
3. Each club will make and bring 2 baskets with a minimum value of \$25 each to Encanto in November for the Shalimar match in December. Deadline to turn in 2 baskets is the 3<sup>rd</sup> match at Encanto.
4. Each year the chairman of the league (Nancy this year and next) will check with each course to see if the slope and rating has been changed. This is done to calculate handicaps for the home course.
5. When playing golf, honors are given to the low gross score per hole and not the low net score with dots.
6. Distance Finder handout Memo will be added to each scorecard with the local rules when handing out scorecards at your home match. The handout can be found on the internet on the "Team Captains Duties" page, bullet #7 has the "Distance Device Sharing" memo.
7. Captains will email their lineups with handicap index and carts needed by Friday noon to [coachellis@cox.net](mailto:coachellis@cox.net) Also make sure you turn in your total teams handicaps for the month. Subs for realignment of your golfers are allowed before Saturday noon. Subs after Saturday high noon must have an equal or higher handicap but will play to the handicap of the player they substitute for.
8. Handicap index is always a number with a decimal. Your handicap for your course has no decimal.
9. Maximum handicap you "play to" is 15. Maximum strokes, dots or pops given is 4 per golfer. Anyone with a higher handicap can play but will be playing to a 15 handicap.
10. Collect \$10 (\$1 from each player) at each match and turn this in when collecting your scorecards to pass out to your team.
11. Handout local rules and attach them to each scorecard.
12. The host club has the option of providing food and drink for all players. Thank you for such great treats in the past.
